Dear Family and Friends

My friend has a sign up that says your order for patience has been received. Please wait four to six months for delivery. I have been finding some days quite challenging as I wait. I know God is in control and it's in His timing, but some days I have difficulty believing it. A friend reminded me of Moses and how he got tired and he had to have his arms held up so he could keep going, so thank you for praying and helping me to hold up while I wait.

The school has applied for the visa and have had a letter back confirming that the application has been received, but how long it will be before it is actioned is an unknown.

The new school year started with a Bible vacation week led by a team from the States. It sounds like they had a fun time and learned lots. There is a new 4 year old boy at the school. He has arrived with no language at all. He doesn't even know his name. He has a lot of frustrations, because of not being able to make his needs and wants known.

James continues to struggle with rejection as he realizes that he can no longer live with his Aunt and Uncle. Pray for him and Betsy as they work through this together.

Kristian has made a good return to school and seems settled and ready to work.

As for me I have been doing a little bit of relief teaching at my old school. Just recently I was commissioned by my church as a pastoral visitor. It has been encouraging to meet up with people from the fellowship, hear their stories and pray for them.

Thanks for praying for an increase in my finances. I now have almost 100% support. I need a further \$40 a month in order to achieve this.
