

Those interested in coming as Mission Work Teams:

1. Contact the school office for a doctrinal statement OR read it on this web site. After reading the doctrinal statement, if your team members are in agreement with or can accept the terms of the doctrinal statement for the time of your visit, continue to step 2.
2. Obtain a Visitors Request application from this web site OR prepare a statement of purpose for organizational purposes to be given in advance to the ESD administration office. Include:
 - a. proposed dates of coming,
 - b. type of work or ministry the visitors/team would like to do
 - c. name and age of each team member (specify any special skills – sign language, plumbing, drama, crafts, Spanish, cooking, general laborer)
 - d. name, address, phone number and e-mail address of team leader
 - e. name, address, phone number and e-mail address of team organizer (if different than d)
3. After submitting your proposal/statement of purpose, someone from ESD will contact your team organizer/leader. A date will be negotiated depending on needs – housing in the school dorms or other housing, ability to rent vehicles for transportation or loan school vehicles, time of year and staff availability to assist or organize, etc.
4. Once dates are in place, we will finalize plans from ESD as much as possible. An itinerary for the group will be drawn up in agreement with the organizer/leader. All team members will be expected to agree to the decisions made by the leadership. A balance between ministry and play/relaxation can be arranged.
5. Keep open communication channels between your leadership and your team as well as between the ESD leadership and missionaries. Weekly exchanges are suggested within the last 6 weeks of preparations before coming. Please have all team members bring medications, etc.
